The Winners of the race were The Legends made up of Sean Gilfillan, Lisa Crawford and Angie Crawford, with Sean and Kelvin Fletcher achieving the fastest laps of the day.

The Grand Prix was part of a larger event being organised to raise funds for the Anthony Nolan Trust at BA County Stores at the Lyne of Skene. The event raised hundreds of thousands of pounds for the charity and we hope to host the grand prix the next time the event is held in the North East.



On the Sunday the Kildrummy Vintage Rally returned to the park for the 3rd year. Despite the rain lots of spectators turned up to look at the vehicles and walk around the park. Nearly 50 veteran, vintage and classic vehicles of all shapes and sizes, aged 25 years and over, were lined up for all to see.

The Rally was the first of its kind in the North East and has been running since 1958, being held previously at Kildrummy and at Leith Hall. As part of the day the drivers head out on a country drive which takes in over 38 miles of Aberdeenshire Roads. Despite the weather over half the vehicles took on this drive. We are looking forward to the Rally returning to the park for a fourth time in June 2011.

Joining Forces with Lumphanan Golf Course!

Ourselves and Lumphanan golf course have joined forces to offer more for our guests. We are able to offer golf as part of a full day package which would be, half a day doing activities at the park, then we will transport you to the golf course to let you play a round of golf there.

Also when we have family fun days or large corporate days we can offer golf as an extra activity as part of the package.

Lumphanan golf course is 1859 yards, it's a classic hillside course which is par 62 with spectacular views towards upper Deeside. Depending on the time of year you can also see many types of wildlife including deer, curlew, oyster catchers, partridge and buzzards.

Lumphanan golf course was established in 1924, and the club thrived in its early years. In the 1930's it was possible to buy a Sunday excursion train ticket from Aberdeen to Lumphanan for 4s/6d which included a round of golf and afternoon tea at the hotel.

After the second world war membership declined and then the Royal Deeside Railway was disbanded in 1967, this led to the disrepair of the course. Then in the late 1980's there were moves to rebuild the 9-hole course. Lots of hard work, sheer determination and fundraising led to the club finally reopening in 1994 and it has flourished since becoming a great part of the community.
